Panel Saw Safety Rules

The panel saw is used to cut large sheet goods to size..

Rip cuts are possible with this saw, however we prefer to use the table saw for ripping so for our purposes this saw is limited to cross cutting.

Place the material that you want to cut on the rollers (do not drop materials onto the rollers as this will destroy the accuracy of the machine) make sure that the material is against the machine frame. Roll the material into position for the cut - use the attached tape measures to accurately position the material. Un-lock the carriage and turn the saw on. Pull the saw down slowly. Be sure to pull the saw the whole way to the bottom of the carriage guide. Shut the saw off before assisting the saw back to the top of the carriage guide. Re-lock the saw carriage.

Safety

- 1. Be sure that the edge of the material that rests on the rollers is completely straight.
- 2. Do not cut pieces smaller than the saw carriage.
- 3. Keep proper footing and balance at all times.
- Always cut from the top down.
- 5. Wait for the blade to stop before moving your material.
- 6. Do not place your hands on or under the saw carriage or in the path of the blade.
- Do not try to retrieve a piece of cut material while the blade is rotating.
