

SCROLL SAW SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Set the pressure foot down against the stock before turning on the power.
2. Before you turn on the scroll saw, be sure that the blade tension is properly adjusted to keep the blade from bending or breaking.
3. When cutting, do not have your hands directly in line with the saw blade.
4. You should hand turn the scroll saw to be sure it is properly adjusted before turning on the power. This procedure is only for the early model scroll saws.
5. Never clean scraps of material near the moving blade with your fingers.
6. If small pieces get caught in the throat against the saw blade, be sure to stop the machine before trying to remove them.
7. A variable speed scroll saw should be started at the slowest speed setting, and the speed should be adjusted back to the slowest setting before turning off the power.
8. When installing a new blade, make sure the teeth of the blade are pointing down so the cutting action is towards the table of the scroll saw.

If you are apprehensive about using this machine, have the instructor assist you.

Always wear approved eye protection while using this machine.
