ROUTER SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. You need the teacher's permission to use the router.
- 2. When you are going to use the router, you should clamp the stock down or use a vise to keep it secure.
- 3. You should always unplug the router before making any type of adjustment or cutter bit changes.
- 4. Use only the proper wrenches when you change bits, cutters, or attachments. The instructor must approve any special set-ups.
- 5. The teacher must approve all adjustments before you turn on the power.
- 6. Be sure the router switch is in the off position before you plug in the router.
- 7. Hold the router tightly whenever the power is turned on.
- 8. Keep both hands on the router when in use.
- 9. Router cuts are made with a steady, fast movement.
- 10. When you finish the cutting operation, turn off the power immediately.
- 11. The cutter must not touch the material when the power is turned on. Turning on the power with the cutter touching the material can break the blade.
- 12. When using a router, do not lean too close to your work. Your hair or clothing may be caught in the machinery. Long hair must be tied back.
- 13. When using a router, protect your eyes from flying chips and/or pieces of broken cutter bits by wearing approved eye protection.

If you are apprehensive about using this machine, have the instructor assist you.
