Job Description

The Cosmetology Hairstyling Service program is a central campus program for VACTE which is a Career Technical Education District in the Verde Valley in Arizona. VACTE satellite schools are Camp Verde HS, Mingus HS, Sedona Red Rock HS, local charter schools and home school students. The teacher will be responsible for implementing the state standards for Cosmetology Hairstyling and Related in the daily lessons. This course will introduce and train students in the basic to advanced skills necessary to pursue a career in Cosmetology Hairstyling. This course covers the following topics: prepares individuals to cut, trim, and style scalp, facial, and body hair; massage the head and extremities; and prepare for practice as licensed cosmetologists in specialized or full-service salons. This program includes instruction in hair cutting and styling, shampooing, chemical applications, shop management, sanitation and safety, customer service, and applicable professional and labor laws and regulations.

Part Time to Full Time position, 20 to 40 hours per week plus additional Prop 301 and CTSO Stipends. Possible class time will be 7:00 am to 9:30 am and/or 1:15 pm to 4:00 pm Monday – Thursday with an estimated 10 Saturdays (8 hrs. each). Start date: Aug. 1st, 2023.
