## Valley Academy for Career & Technology Education (VACTE)

### Required Qualification

- Valid Arizona Career Technical Education teaching certification with certification in Education & Training and/or Family Consumer Science/Business & Marketing
- Valid Arizona Department of Public Safety Fingerprint Clearance Card IVP
- A minimum of 3 years of verified teaching experience
- Master's Degree in Education (Any area in educational related studies.)

### Job Description

The Education Professions program will be a central campus program for VACTE which is a Career Technical Education District in the Verde Valley and Sedona area in Arizona. VACTE satellite schools are Camp Verde HS, Mingus HS and Sedona Red Rock HS. Students in grades 10<sup>th</sup> through the year after graduation can enroll in the program from public schools, private schools, charter schools or home school. The Education Professions teacher will be responsible for implementing the state standards for Education Professions in the daily lessons. Hands-on activities will be implemented for the students to learn work-based skills and teaching activities and skills. The teacher will be responsible for setting up and monitoring the students in a practicum setting in local school district classrooms around the Verde Valley and Sedona area. The program will cover first aid, CPR, confidentiality, lesson plan development, teaching strategies, use of technology in education, lesson delivery, assessment, classroom management and classroom environment. The students will receive credit from Yavapai College through dual enrollment. The teacher must be certified to teach the dual enrolled courses through Yavapai College (Master's Degree in Education will be needed).

### **Other:**

**Part Time to Full Time position**, 20 to 40 hours per week. (.5 FTE to 1.0 FTE) + Prop 301 and CTSO Stipend. Class time will be 7:00 am to 9:35 am and possibly 1:20 pm to 4:00 pm (If full time) Monday – Thursday. Start date: Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026.
